Guidelines for Parent/Guardian-Provided Costume Pieces:

1. Costumes should be character and age-appropriate.
2. Costumes should fit within a determined color palette.
3. Costumes must allow for movement without the fabric ripping or exposing the skin.
4. Costumes should be made of light, breathable material to prevent overheating.
5. All shoes must be comfortable and appropriate for dancing if required.

Costume Check Dates for the following parts:

- Thursday, November 2, 2023: All requested costume pieces must be on campus for a Full Run-Through of the Musical
- Students will participate in a costume parade on Saturday, November 4, 2023. Some costume adjustments may take place after this event.

Please begin assembling your child's costume requirements so they can be turned in on November 2, 2023.
